

NAFA Dues Reduction/Waiver Request

NAFA Regular Members and Associate Members (and former NAFA Regular Members and Associate Members) may petition the NAFA Board of Directors for a reduction or waiver of dues if they find themselves in a hardship situation. Hardships may include, but are not limited to, loss of employment, permanent disability, sabbaticals, significant reduction in compensation, or leaves of absence.

To request a reduction or waiver of dues, simply describe your situation and why you believe a dues reduction or waiver is warranted in a short message addressed to the NAFA President. Please be sure to request a specific reduction in dues. Also include your complete contact information in the message. Send your message via email to info@nafa.org or via regular mail to NAFA President, Suite 200, 125 Village Blvd., Princeton, NJ 08540.

Notes:

- Dues reductions/waivers are valid for a maximum of 12 months.
- NAFA reserves the right to revoke any reductions/waivers if NAFA learns information provided is false, or if NAFA learns the reason(s) for reduction/waiver no longer exist.
- Students and Web Subscriber are not eligible for a dues waiver/reduction.
- Former NAFA Regular Members and former NAFA Associate Members may request a dues reduction/waiver only if such request is made to NAFA within the first 12 months of their membership cancellation.
